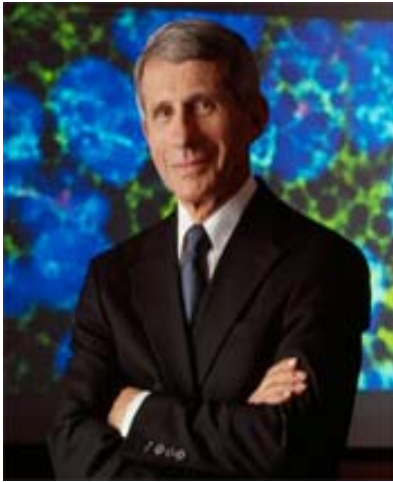

DIRECTIONS TO RECEPTION IN CAPITOL VISITOR CENTER

(from Dirksen Senate Office Building)

- 1) Exit Dirksen Senate Office Building through South-West exit, onto **Constitution Avenue NE**
- 2) Head *west* on **Constitution Avenue NE** towards **First Street NE**
- 3) Turn **LEFT** onto First Street NE
- 4) Head *south* on **First Street NE** towards **East Capitol Street**
- 5) Follow signs for Capitol Visitor Center Entrance (on your right)
- 6) Once you have entered, you will need to go through security, then proceed to HVC-201

FOR VISITORS WITH DISABILITIES
