ROOTED IN THE COMMUNITY SINCE 1969

CDC Statistics

- There are 2.7 – 3.9 million persons living with HCV in the United States
- Most are unaware that they are infected
- 45% of persons ever infected with HCV reported no known exposure risk
- Although persons born during 1945 – 1965 comprise an estimated 27% of the population, they account for approximately 75% of all HCV infections in the United States

Acacia Network Statistics

- From January 2014 – December 2014 Acacia Network providers conducted universal routine HCV screening .
- 4,686 individuals were screened
- 749 HCV Ab Positive results (16%)
- 345 (46%) of the HCV infected individuals were born outside of the birth cohort
