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# STATEMENT OF PROBLEM

- The major problem for studies without a randomized control is lack of insurance for homogeneity of groups.
- "... it is the absence of randomization that is crucial, for since this device is not available there is no clear-cut distinction between factors which are explicitly accounted for in the hypothetical model and disturbing factors which are summed up in the residual variation." (Wold, 1956)
