
Insanity. It may be even more futile and counterproductive than the condom campaigns.






- ▶ V 2.0 The apology tour December 4, 2012
 - "HIV Prevention Pill for Negative Men: Another choice for staying HIV free?"
 - "Over the past few days since the email was sent, the message has been mischaracterized by some of the gay press. It's been suggested that we are promoting bad science, that we're advocating for everyone to stop using condoms and start taking the pill, and that we've been paid to promote Truvada. None of these statements are true."
 - "We would like to apologize to our members and anyone else that felt confused by the message of our initial World AIDS Day campaign and gay press coverage."



Recommendations – Address Stigma

- Reframe "safer sex." No more deferring to "wear a condom every time."
 - Telling people to take a pill every day + condoms = CRAY CRAY
 - Taking PrEP as prescribed IS "safer sex"
 - ▶ Intimacy and pleasure not 4-letter words
- Provide platforms for the voices of PrEP users
