



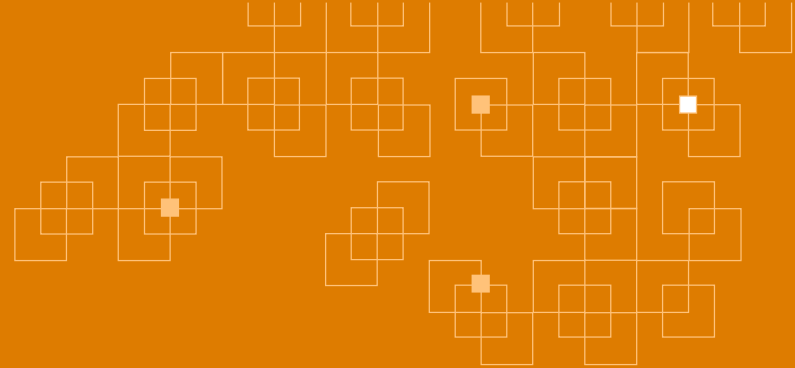

Reminders

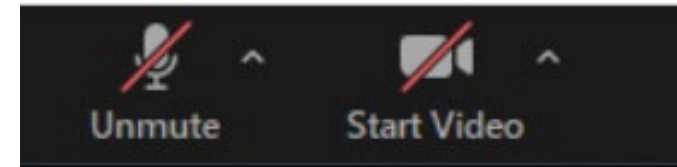
- We restrict participation to experts with the necessary scientific knowledge from organizations or entities with a clear commitment to advancing the therapeutic field related to HBV.

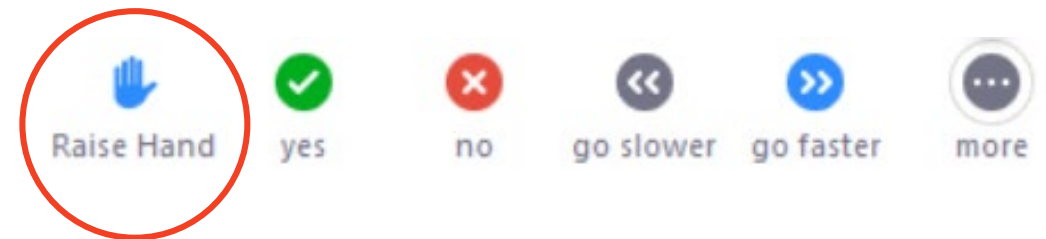

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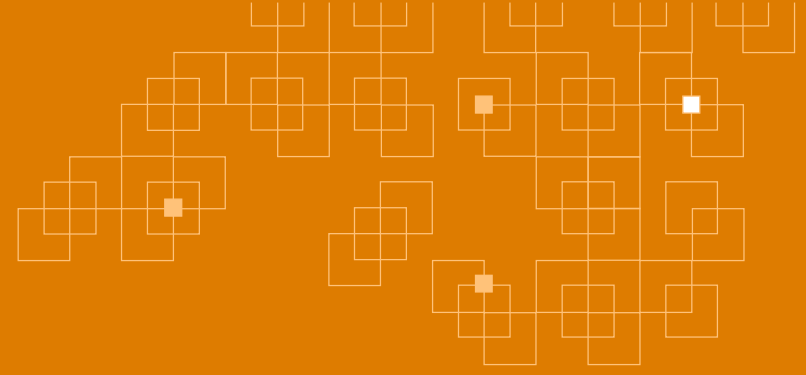
