

# International Workshop on NASH Biomarkers

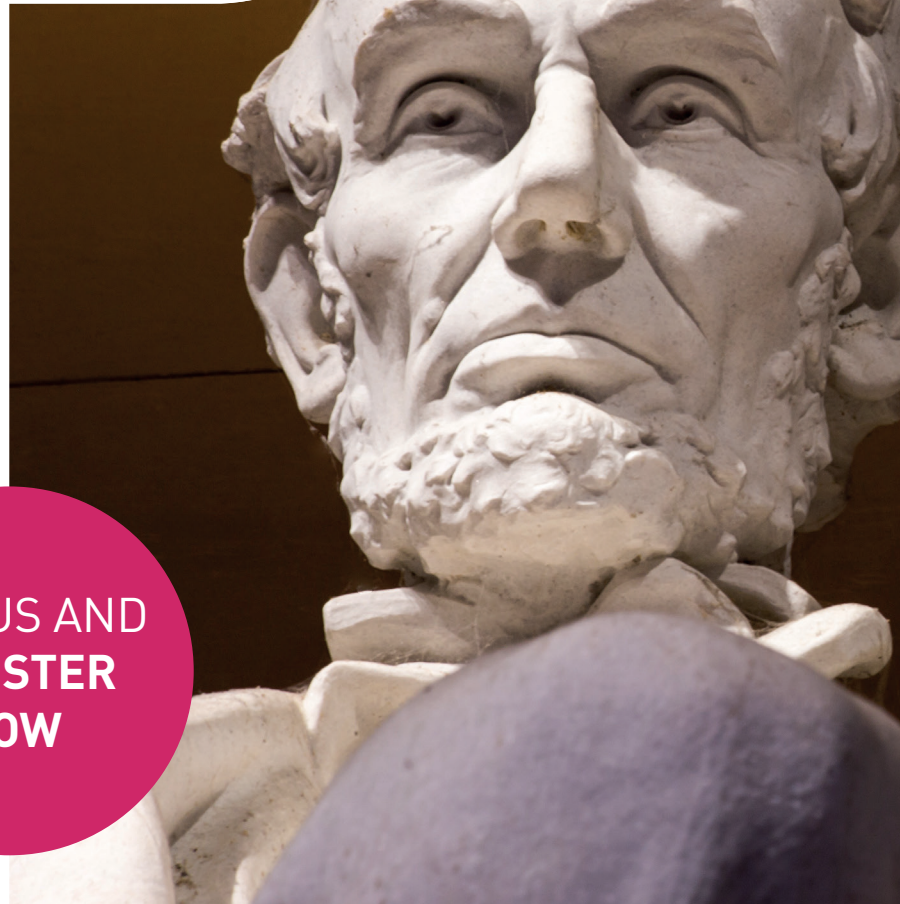
