

Forum Mission



Major Recommendations from Forum WG Roundtables

- Use sentinel-site based methodology for collecting toxicity data in a standardized format
- Make best use of currently ongoing observational cohort studies
- Engage all stakeholders (including program sponsors and pharmaceutical industry) in the effort

- Bring together the traditional pharmacovigilance and the HIV treatment communities
- Establish a common framework for the reporting of HIV treatment related adverse events in various regions
