
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The UFO Model intervention

What: The UFO Model is a multi-


component, multi-level hepatitis education and prevention intervention

 Who: UFO serves young adult IDU under age 30



 Why: Young adult IDUs are at high risk for HCV, HIV, accidental overdose






UFO Model philosophy

Core elements



- Harm reduction philosophy
- Youth-centered focus
- Outreach and consistency
- Collaboration and referrals






UFO Model components

Modular, flexible, adaptable

- 1. Outreach and education
- 2. Youth-centered referrals
- 3. Drop-in center
- 4. Syringe access



6. Education and support group








Issues affecting UFO Model implementation

- HCV testing
 - Access, only antibody, no training
- Hepatitis education
 - Inaccurate materials, misconceptions
- Outreach
 - Young adults population, suburbs, lack of awareness
- Policy
 - Funding disparities; priorities
